- Must be a graduate of a high school located in one of the following South Carolina counties: Aiken, Calhoun, Chester, Chesterfield, Darlington, Edgefield, Fairfield, Florence, Kershaw, Lancaster, Lee, Lexington, Marlboro, Newberry, Orangeburg, Richland, Saluda, and Sumter.
- Submit a complete application that includes: a typed application, an official transcript, essay, and two letters of recommendation
- Must be a registered voter (exceptions allowed for applicants who are not yet 18 years old)
- Must be a U. S. Citizen
